The Link Street 88E6021 device is a 3-port Quality of Service (QoS) switch integrating a high-performance switching fabric with four priority queues, a high-speed address look-up engine, two 10/100 Ethernet PHY ports for either copper or fiber connections, one MII port, three independent Media Access Controllers (MACs), and Spanning Tree support. Other advanced features include 802.1p/IPv4/IPv6 traffic classification, 802.1Q VLAN and extensive RMON counters. The 88E6021 switch is an ideal product for wireless gateway routers, IP phones, media converters, and Multi-Tenant Unit (MTU) gateways.




Fig 1. Link Street 88E6021 SOHO Switch Internal Block Diagram

The 88E6021 switch's high integration, low power and extra port supports many applications with few additional active components in a small footprint. The flexibility of the 88E6021 device comes from its configuration options and integration. The device supports an optional EEPROM to override any desired QoS default settings. The 88E6021 switch contains PHYs, LED drivers, voltage regulator logic, QoS switch logic, and memory. The only active components required to implement a complete 88E6021 10/100 Ethernet switch are a 25 MHz crystal clock source and a low cost PNP transistor used by the 88E6021 device's voltage regulator to generate 2.5V from 3.3V.




Fig 2. Media Converter Application
